# Centenary and Boarding Scholarships

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## 1. Centenary Scholarships

Centenary Scholarships provide for remission of one third academic fees for one, two or three years' duration depending on year level of entry. Centenary Scholarships are open to all girls not currently attending Walford School and for entry at Years 5 to 12.

## 2. Boarding Scholarships

Boarding Scholarships provide for remission of one third or one half academic fees. The duration of the award is dependent on the year level of entry. Boarding Scholarships are open to all girls not currently attending Walford School and for entry at Years 6 to 12.

3. Applicants may apply for either or both of the above awards.
4. Criteria for selection include academic achievement, personal qualities and involvement in co-curricular activities.
5. Candidates should complete the accompanying Scholarship Application form and return it to the Director of Admissions, Walford Anglican School for Girls, 316 Unley Road, Hyde Park 5061 **by 5.00pm on Monday 11 February 2008.**
6. **An administration fee of \$25.00 is to accompany the completed application form.**
7. From the application forms received, a short-list of candidates for interview will be established, and awards will be made following an interview of all those short-listed. Candidates residing in remote areas may be interviewed by telephone.
8. All applicants will be advised in due course of the outcome of their application.
9. The continuation each year of the scholarships awarded is subject to satisfactory conduct and satisfactory progress reports of the successful candidate.
10. The Scholarship is awarded on the understanding that the successful candidate will complete her secondary education at Walford Anglican School for Girls.
11. Financial circumstances may be taken into consideration. Details should be provided in a sealed envelope marked "In confidence" and addressed to the Principal. This should accompany your application. Confidential bursaries may be available to assist with fees in cases of financial hardship. These are awarded annually and are subject to a means test.
