



UPGRADING HISTORY

Walford Anglican School for Girls has this year undertaken a restoration of the heritage-listed Reed House. Reed House was built in 1854 as the Unley Private Hospital, prior to becoming part of Walford's Junior School. An assembly was held last month to celebrate the completion of works, which featured a speech from old scholar Libby Robertson (*pictured*), who was born in the hospital in 1947. The building will be used as a science and technology hub as of next year, though it is designed to be flexible for future demands.
