JUBILEE & BOARDING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2020

Jubilee Scholarships provide for remission of up to 20% academic fees for up to five years' duration depending on year level of entry. Jubilee Scholarships are open to all girls **not currently attending** Walford School and for entry at Years 5 to 12.

Boarding Scholarships provide for remission of up to one half academic fees. The duration of the award is dependent on the year level of entry. Boarding Scholarships are open to all girls **not currently attending** Walford School and for entry at Years 6 to 12.

The scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal and are subject to a quota which is determined by the Council of Governors. Should the quota of scholarships not be awarded, applications will remain open for the calendar year.

Applicants may apply for either or both of the above awards.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Criteria for selection include academic achievement, personal qualities and involvement in co-curricular activities.

From the application forms received, a short-list of candidates for interview will be established, and awards will be made following an interview of all those short-listed. Candidates residing in remote areas may be interviewed by telephone.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

Scholarships awarded to successful candidates will **replace** any existing Walford scholarships where the tenure and remission are of greater value.

The scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will finish her secondary education at Walford and as a boarding student if applicable. The continuation of the scholarship each year is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, displaying conduct of a high standard and contributing to the life of the school through participation in co-curricular activities.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Financial circumstances may be taken into consideration. Details should be provided in a sealed envelope marked "In confidence" and addressed to the Principal. This should accompany your application. Confidential bursaries may be available to assist with fees in cases of financial hardship. These are awarded annually and are subject to a means test.

Candidates should complete the relevant Scholarship Application form available online via the Walford website and return it to the Director of Admissions, Walford Anglican School for Girls, 316 Unley Road, Hyde Park 5061

Applications close 5.00pm Thursday 31 January 2019.

An administration fee of \$35.00 is to accompany the completed application form.

The School will not enter into further discussion or dispute regarding the awarding of these scholarships. All applicants will be advised in due course of the outcome of their application.
