



MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2020

Walford offers two Music scholarships which provide for remission of half tuition fees for up to five years:

- **Rosalie Anne Taylor Music Scholarship:** Awarded to a new or continuing student.
- **Music Entrance Scholarship:** Awarded to a student entering Walford.

These scholarships are available for students who demonstrate an outstanding aptitude in music. They are awarded at the discretion of the Principal by recommendation from the Music Coordinator. Successful candidates must also demonstrate a sound academic record and the potential to make a positive contribution to the school in general. Scholarships may be awarded on a shared basis.

MUSIC TUITIONSHIPS

Walford offers tuitionship to students who are able to demonstrate an ability to contribute to the Music Department in a unique way.

- Tuitionship is aimed at encouraging students to undertake tuition on a certain instrument for the benefit of the music program as a whole.
- Tuitionship provides remission for hire of instrument and/or instrumental lessons.
- Tuitionship is awarded at the discretion of the Music Coordinator

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

Music scholarships are open to students studying at Walford or at any other school. A candidate should be of approximately Grade 5 standard in her first instrument.

Scholarships awarded to successful candidates will **replace** any existing Walford scholarships where the tenure and remission are of greater value.

The scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will finish her secondary education at Walford with the study of Music an integral part of this. The continuation of the scholarship each year is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, displaying conduct of a high standard and contributing to the life of the school through participation in Music and other co-curricular activities.

Tuitionship is awarded on the understanding that the recipient will, on their chosen instrument, contribute to the music program at Walford as much as can reasonably be expected.

AUDITIONS

Auditions will be held prior to the award of Music Scholarships. Candidates should be prepared to play 2 pieces of contrasting character and may be asked to play a scale or exercise. Where a candidate can play other instruments, she should be prepared to show her ability on them.

The audition will include some aural tests and sight-reading as well as a discussion to indicate musical knowledge based on the pieces played and the candidate's general interest in music.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates should complete the relevant Scholarship Application form available online via the Walford website and return it to the Director of Admissions, Walford Anglican School for Girls, 316 Unley Road, Hyde Park 5061

Applications close 5.00pm Thursday 31 January 2019.

An application fee of \$35.00 must accompany the completed application form.

FURTHER INFORMATION

The School will not enter into further discussion or dispute regarding the awarding of these scholarships or tuitionships. No report of any candidate's results will be given, however all applicants will be advised in due course of the outcome of their application.
